- 2-D artwork should be matted or mounted on cardstock or construction paper but does not need to be framed.
- Work need not be for sale, but we receive many inquiries each year from visitors interested in purchasing art from this show.

Young artists interested in submitting their work for display should fill out the attached registration form and deliver their artwork to the Old Court House Arts Center, located at 101 N. Johnson Street in Woodstock on the drop off dates listed above. Artwork must be delivered with the registration form and entry fee of \$5.
